To teach Orthodoxy through our Introductory Course, THE WAY, now in use everywhere in the Englishspeaking world, and adopted throughout the Patriarchate of Romania for adult catechesis.



To house a library that embraces the history and practice of Orthodoxy in this country and the world – and that's just the beginning!



# **BIG CHANGES!**

## THE URGENT NEED

Is for support from ordinary Orthodox people to keep us going. Our reserves have been exhausted in purchasing the building, which is a valuable asset, with enormous scope for development - but we need your help to maintain and expand our activities in the service of the Church.



A hundred supporters, each giving us, say, £20 a month by standing order, would help the finances by £24,000 a year. If they each approached a rich friend and suggested £100 a month, that would be £24,000 plus another £120,000 = £144,000 - and then we would be offering scholarships to students who couldn't afford to pay.

**HOW TO HELP** Overleaf is a form to make a donation by Standing Order: just fill in the details, return it to us, and we'll do the rest. But if you are a British taxpayer and fill in the GIFT-AID form also, the Government will give us another 28% on your donation, making that £144,000 up to £184,320. So though we may feel like St Paul's Christians, 'little and of no account', we are not in fact powerless at all: our 'small change' can change the world!
